## HOW APUW UNIVERSITY OPERATES

**Auream Phoenix University** operates with full legal authority and accepts students from all over the world. Prior to each enrolment, the University informs candidates on its study systems as well as on the value of its academic qualifications. Our University holds a Certificate of Incorporation and a Certificate of Good Standing from the Government of the Republic of Panama. It is also registered in Italy at the Chamber of Commerce of the city of Ragusa therefore under Italian tax authority. APUW answers to the Commonwealth on academic qualifications and business university conduct. It is legally authorized to carry out all the activities of a private international post-secondary educational institution with reference to point 4 of its own statute. APUW University can award degrees up to doctoral level.

### **It is an International University with no governmental accreditation.**

Auream Phoenix University programs by Distance Learning are tailored on the student's needs and cover dozens of disciplines including: management, economy, communications, humanities, arts, psychology, holistic sciences, computer, interior design and so on. A general assessment of the student's curriculum always precedes the candidate student enrolment; that determines the amount of transferable credits from previous learning and work experience. Auream Phoenix has adopted the current European Credit Transfer System (ECTS) guidelines and the US GAAP Generally Accepted Accrediting Practices. The established value of APUW University credits is the following: 1 APUW credit equals 2 ECTS.

*via Distance Learning*





The Bachelor is a university degree normally awarded after completing a three/four-years degree course (depending on the country and university) in a specific field. The goal is to lead students towards their professional careers.

Offers online Bachelor's Degrees via Distance Learning, the equivalent of a four-year degree. APUW University's Bachelors are available in over 200 fields of study, including the arts, business, engineering and technology, law, humanities, social sciences, biological and life sciences, natural sciences, holistic and religious sciences. Within each of these fields of study, there are numerous specializations that guarantee the student exclusivity in the programs offered.

Auream Phoenix University guarantees the possibility of identifying a study program and obtaining a degree in line with one's professional field through the A.P.E.L. (Accreditation Prior Experiential Learning) evaluation of the candidate's CV. This will allow managers, professionals, entrepreneurs and consultants to get a tremendous boost in their professional careers.



## FLEXIBLE STUDY PROGRAM

Adult students are different from younger students. They learn only what they need to learn and not what they already know, which is why the APEL system is a remarkable opportunity, allowing students enrolled in distance Bachelors programs to save time, energy and money.

Adult degree programs are therefore practical and motivating.

The online Bachelor's Degree via Distance Learning by APEL enhances students' knowledge and expertise allowing them not to linger on subjects they already know well because of their experience in the field of management, professions or employee fields. Through Auream Phoenix's Bachelor's Degree programs, students complete the framework of their competencies and skills to take a great advantage for their career progression and professional legitimacy.

The online degree program via Distance Learning by APEL is based on the study of textbooks and recognition of prior professional credits.

Recognition of professional credits is based on evaluation of the student's CV, while examinations consist of 15 pages written reports based on assigned textbooks. In some cases, and under certain conditions, the final dissertation can be directly accessed.

An Auream Phoenix University Bachelor's Degree requires 120 academic credits, approximately 2000 hours of study according to the USA semester credit system, equivalent to three years of study at a traditional university.

Through the APEL system, professional and prior education credits can be transferred to reduce academic requirements and the degree achievement timing.



## ADMISSION

A distance university is neither for everyone nor for all purposes.

**The admission requirements for the APUW distance learning Bachelor degree are: high school diploma, 30 years old minimum age and at least three years of professional experience in the chosen field of study.** Each candidate has a different profile; that is why APUW examines every single student situation.

**Also note that as a Distance university, APUW does not provide visa and immigration services.**

The minimum programs duration varies from one to three years according to the student's professional and scholastic CV and engagement in studying and in the thesis work.



## LOW COST

The cost of a Bachelor Degree at APUW University is among the lowest in the world.

Since all programs are delivered in distance learning modality, costs consistently differ from traditional Campus ones.

All professors, consultants, experts work in smart mode, each from their own locations.

Therefore, students pay low fees because the University has lower costs. ## Master's Degree Online via Distance Learning

A Master's degree requires 40 APUW University credits; that means 80 ECTS over the Bachelor. Auream Phoenix University study approach is innovative and flexible since it focuses on adult students' previous work experience. Credits validation is based on the analysis of the candidates' Curriculum Vitae: life and professional skills, academic achievements, professional experiences, cultural backgrounds and so on. Credits validation for high-profile candidates' CV may allow a straight access to the final thesis.

**Auream Phoenix University distance learning study programs are exclusively provided online.**

Every specific course degree differs from traditional exams based programs; it rather consists in Reports writing implementation (Units examination) and text book reading.

Our distance degree programs are three:

**Master of Arts (MA)**

**Master of Sciences (Msc)**

Auream Phoenix University is a Private International Commercial University incorporated in the Republic of Panama.





**APUW University works online through an internet e-learning platform; its distance learning system uses e-mail, international couriers, video telephone systems, etc.**

Note that certain government agencies employers or some professional licensing bodies may require degrees which are directly regulated by a national Ministry of Education. An APUW University degree is valid for many purposes but not for all.

We recommend foreign students to check APUW University Master usability to their goals. The study programs costs are determined by APUW Credits. For a Master, each credit is equal to 150 USD/Euros; however, CV credits validation may gain a cost/credits reduction up to 70%.

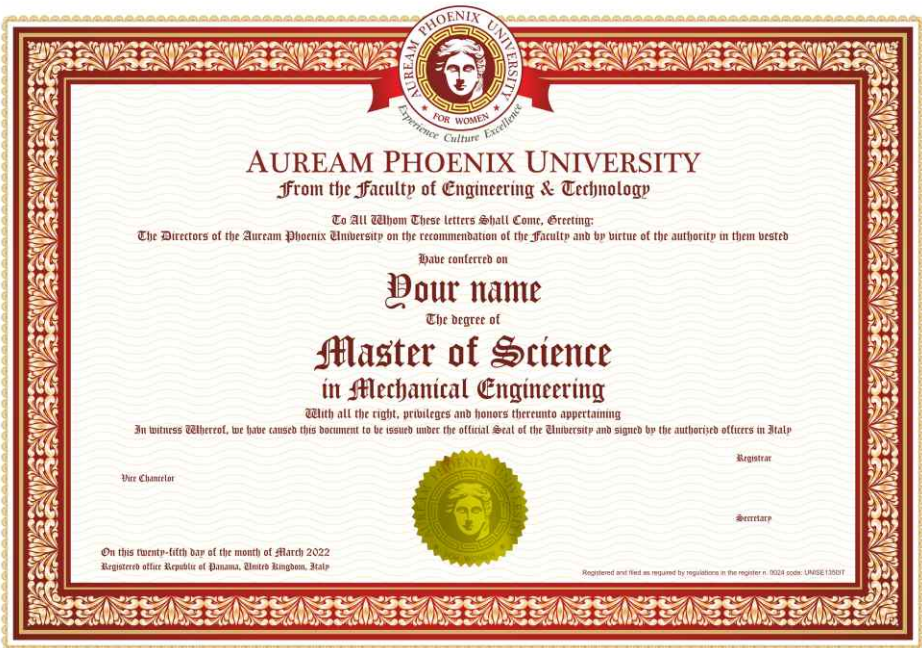
The entire program cost is determined by credits amount obtained by the candidate according to her CV and her prior learning. It is necessary to send a thoroughly detailed CV in order to know the study program cost. The Secretariat will process the candidate's CV, giving account of the credits number earned by the student. This result will be communicated through a document called "Provisional Certificate": it displays the program final cost.

A Master specifically requires 40 APUW University Credits, in addition to the Bachelor degree. That means a total 160 Credits (Bachelor + Master), equivalent to 320 ECTS. Obviously, the more credits the student earns through CV validation, the more the program cost will lower. At least 50% of the total number of credits required by any adult study program must be transferred from the previous education experience and/or validated by professional experience. A maximum of 70% of the total number of credits required by the distance degree program can be transferred from professional and life experience.

**A PhD by Research** via Distance Learning perfectly adjusts to adult students' needs, that is to people having work and family commitments yet willing to go through alternative academic path.

**Auream Phoenix for Women is an independent private international university that helps adult international students achieving their academic goals.**

Over the years, several surveys have shown that via Distance Learning PhDs by research can be as useful as those earned by traditional academic systems. Clearly, it has to be granted that the private institution is highly reputable. In this regard, Auream Phoenix University has acquired a respectable and trustworthy reputation, always giving personal skills and professionalism the deserved emphasis.

Nowadays, Auream Phoenix University represents an important alternative to traditional studies, above all if we consider the digital era and the global village we live in. Our study system is geared towards busy people pacing today world rhythms. As a matter of fact, it is efficiently transmitted among computer devices anywhere in the world.

**Doctor of Philosophy (PhD), in Latin: Philosophiae Doctor or Doctor Philosophiae, is the highest academic degree awarded.** It usually covers all academic programs. As graduate researchers, PhD students are usually required to show competence, master their topic research but also carry out an original thesis so as to foster new academic contributions in their knowledge field.

**A PhD via distance learning is an original academic research in a specific branch of human knowledge. The candidate works autonomously and his/her project culminates in a final doctoral thesis.**



**Unlike any other traditional campus based PhD, Auream Phoenix University PhD by Research does not have semesters splitting; it rather consists in an independent and autonomous theoretical research on a specific academic area. This research is implemented in a final thesis that students shall complete within 24 months.**

Stress is given on independence during study and research; reason why students' supervisors will not actually be tutor as in common understanding, but rather specialised consultants for students' assistance. The student can use both textbooks and the Internet for research purpose besides having access to the online library. Working freely and independently on their research, students will grow highly specialized knowledge and specific expertise to display in their doctoral thesis defense. The Distance Learning PhD is earned after successfully completing and defending the final doctoral thesis in the academic major that has been chosen. The "Doctor of Philosophy" is the only PhD that can be obtained via Distance Learning. It should be quite clear that any laboratory method or professional practice cannot occur online or through any distance learning system.

The main requirement for a distance learning PhD by Research is to submit and defend the final thesis whose minimum length have to be 90/100 pages. That will be reviewed and evaluated by an academic committee of the Auream Phoenix University for Women. In some cases, previous candidates' publications may be relevant for PhD purposes. In case the thesis credits are not sufficient, in order to have all the required doctoral credits, additional in-depth reports (about 15-20 pages each) based on textbooks may also be requested.



A PhD is often a very popular job requirement in many work areas. Especially in developing countries, with lack of basic job training, the Doctor of Philosophy gets more and more required not only for highly qualified professions, but also for multinationals, non-governmental organizations and private companies' employments. Employees are asked for an academic "certification" higher than a Bachelor's or a Master's degree.

The PhD is the highest educational qualification. Only the best qualified professionals have a PhD. A Master's degree is usually sufficient for most professions. A PhD requires the achievement of a Master's degree or equivalent, that is a minimum of 65 academic credits (about 1000 hours of study) besides a doctoral thesis. Thesis elaboration is a good opportunity to research on specific topics and, in some cases, to share a publication.

**Distance learning Auream Phoenix PhD admission requirements are: Master Degree possession and suitable CV. There is no race, colour, beliefs and/or religion discrimination.**

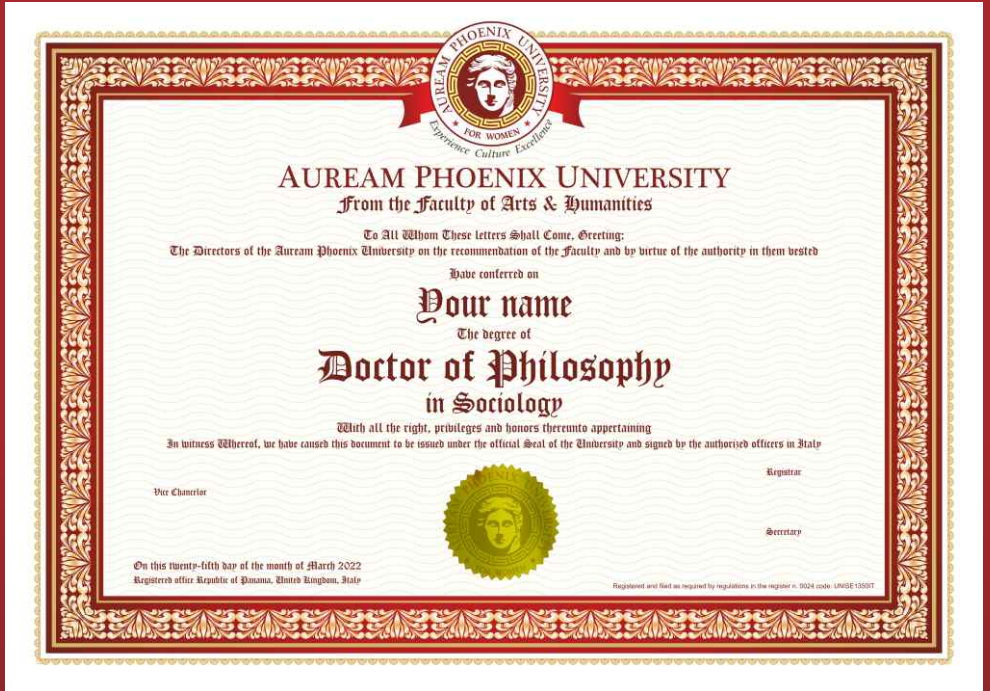

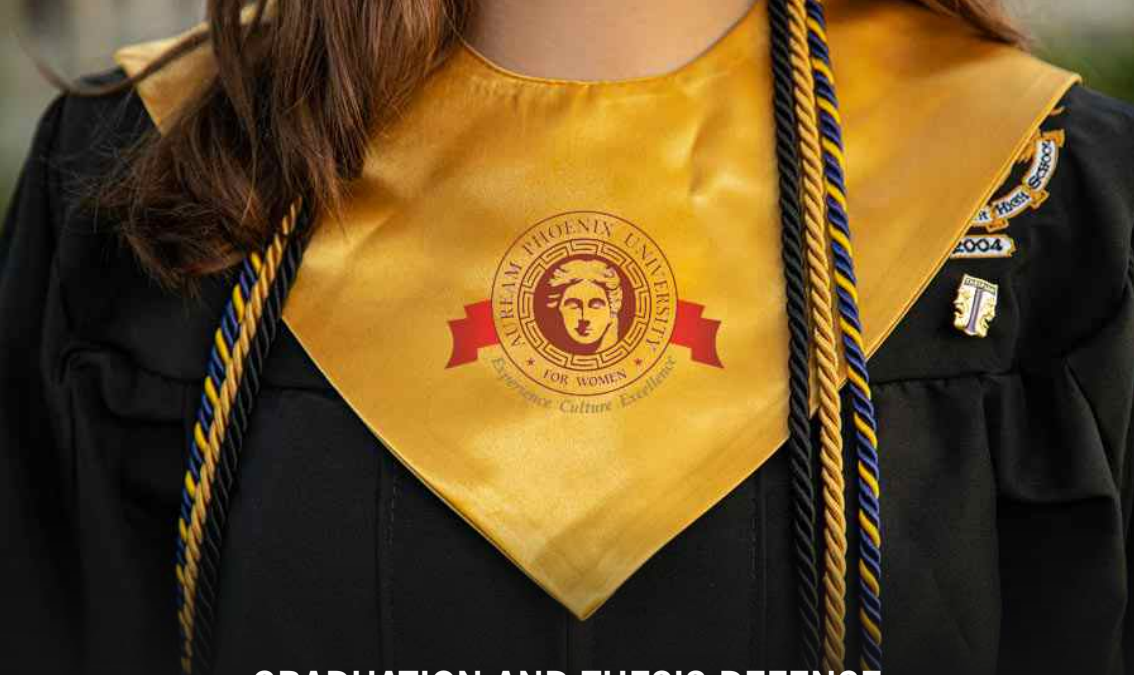

## GRADUATION AND THESIS DEFENCE

In many countries, the candidate has to defend his/her thesis in front of a group of experienced university examiners. Considering that APUW students come from all over the world, often miles away from the university headquarters, **thesis can be defended in three different ways:**

1

### Written defense

the student develops his/her defense in a 5 pages report;

2

### Oral defense

the student sends an audio or video file (at least 30 minutes duration) containing his/her defense;

3

### In attendance

speaking in front of two/three professors of Auream Phoenix. The student sets a date with the secretariat to defend his/her thesis in the Auream Phoenix University headquarters.
